1 On page 4, line 2, after "hollow sections," strike "plate, and  
2 cold formed" and insert "and plate"

3 On page 4, line 6, after "than" strike "25,000" and insert  
4 "50,000"

5 On page 4, at the beginning of line 11, strike "25,000" and  
6 insert "50,000"

7 On page 6, at the beginning of line 25, strike "prior to the  
8 final construction retainage payment" and insert "before substantial  
9 completion"

10 On page 6, line 32, after "the cost of" insert "each of"

11 Beginning on page 6, line 38, after "(3)" strike all material  
12 through "transferable;" on page 7, line 4, and insert "The database  
13 created by the University of Washington college of built environments  
14 pursuant to subsection (2) of this section will publish global  
15 warming potential as reported in the environmental product  
16 declarations.

17 (4) The selected firm for a contract for a covered project must  
18 make good-faith effort to meet the requirements of subsection (1) of  
19 this section.

20 (5) If the selected firm for a contract for a covered project  
21 cannot meet the requirements of subsection (1) of this section, then  
22 the selected firm must report on and provide documentation,  
23 including, but not limited to, letters, emails, and phone logs with  
24 names, dates, and outcomes, demonstrating the specific steps  
25 undertaken to reasonably obtain the data.

26 (6) If the selected firm for a contract for a covered project  
27 cannot meet the requirements of subsections (1) and (4) of this  
28 section on the grounds of hardship, then the selected firm must

1 report on any specific steps taken to obtain the data and demonstrate  
2 at least one of the following:"

3 Renumber the remaining subsections consecutively and correct any  
4 internal references accordingly.

5 On page 7, at the beginning of line 5, strike "(b)" and insert  
6 "(a)"

7 On page 7, at the beginning of line 8, strike "(c)" and insert  
8 "(b)"

EFFECT: (1) Removes cold formed steel products from the list of specific structural steel products identified in the definition of "covered product".

(2) Increases the minimum gross square footage (sq ft) of a "covered project" as defined in the bill, to 50,000 sq ft, from 25,000 sq ft.

(3) Beginning in 2022, requires selected firms to report specified data before substantial completion of the project, rather than prior to the final construction retainage payment.

(4) Requires data is reported for 90% of the cost for each covered product, rather than 90% of the cost of all covered products.

(5) Specifies that the University of Washington database will publish global warming potential as reported in the environmental product declarations.

(6) Modifies the hardship clause.

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
