 - <u>EFFECT:</u> (1) Removes cold formed steel products from the list of specific structural steel products identified in the definition of "covered product".
 - (2) Increases the minimum gross square footage (sq ft) of a "covered project" as defined in the bill, to 50,000 sq ft, from 25,000 sq ft.
 - (3) Beginning in 2022, requires selected firms to report specified data before substantial completion of the project, rather than prior to the final construction retainage payment.
 - (4) Requires data is reported for 90% of the cost for each covered product, rather than 90% of the cost of all covered products.
 - (5) Specifies that the University of Washington database will publish global warming potential as reported in the environmental product declarations.
 - (6) Modifies the hardship clause.

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
